PRAYER & PRAISES

Introduction

Read: Philippians 4:6—7

Read: Genesis 15:5—6

Pray: Dear God, I want to have a strong faith like Abram. Please give me patience to be quiet and hear what You have for me. Amen

Read: Proverbs 3:5—6

Pray: Father God, I know trust is important. I trust that You have a plan for my life, and I will do my best to listen to You and follow your word. Amen

Read: Daniel 6:10

Pray: Hello, God! I'd like to spend more time with You. I want to wake up, check in, and fill You in throughout my day. Forgive me for not spending enough time with You. I want my faith to grow as our relationship deepens. Amen

Read: Romans 12:2

Pray: Dear God, give me strength to lead well and help me support others with strength, always blessing Your name. Amen

Read: Judges 21:25

Pray: Dear God, give me the courage to be different from those around me if they don't follow Your ways, give me faith to love others. Amen

Read: 1 Timothy 6:6—7

Pray: Dear God, thank you for reminding me what is important. Help me to live for You and to value what You value. Amen.

Old Testament
